### What are Cookies

Cookies are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer, to make the website work and work more efficiently. This page breaks down what information the cookies gather, how we use it and why we need to store these cookies. We will also share, how you can stop cookies from being downloaded, but this may have unforeseen circumstance on certain characteristics of the websites functionality.

The use of cookies on our website are for several reasons detailed below. However there is no global standard option for disabling cookies without it affecting certain elements in the websites functionality. Most web browsers acknowledge some form of control over most cookies, through there settings. ### Disabling Cookies

You can stop the placement of cookies by changing the settings on your browser (locate browser help on how to do this). Be wary that disabling cookies can have a serious affect on the functionality of this and several other websites you may visit. Disabling cookies will also result in disabling specific elements and functionality of the website. Therefore it is advised you do not disable cookies.
